Danger: It's all around you – Be aware of your surroundings

Numerous locations at the Center have warning signs and flashing lights

Please heed their warnings – your life, hearing, eyesight, etc may depend on it.





Traffic Safety

- Vehicle speed on LaRC is 25 mph or less, where indicated. Parking lot speed limit is 10 mph.
- Vehicle speed approaching our gates is 15 mph, and 5 mph at the gate itself
- Seat Belt use is **REQUIRED** on the Center.
- Hands free cell phone use only is allowed.
- Pedestrians have right of way in crosswalks



Training, Certification & Permits

Depending on your task, you may need special training, certification, and/or a safety permit:

- Lasers
 - Permitted chemical operations
 - Lockout/Tagout Safety Operators
 - Forklift, Aerial Lift, and Crane operations
 - Respirator users
 - Fall Protection

- If any of your training, certifications, or permits are expired contact your supervisor



Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Make sure you have necessary PPE to complete job tasks
- When in doubt talk to your Supervisor, Facility Safety Head, or Safety (4-SAFE/864-7233)



Emergency Situations

- **To contact Fire/EMS at LaRC**
 - Dialing 911 from any LaRC landline
 - **757-864-2222 from a cellular phone**
 - Make sure you have the building number and location
- For First Aid and minor injuries visit the Occupational Health Clinic at Building 1216

- If you have concerns about a task or see someone about to do something unsafe, speak up.

- Ask yourself
 - What am I about to do?
 - How can it hurt me?
 - What can I do to protect myself?
